The front of the building’s exterior is being completely renovated including removal and replacement of the existing roof façade, replacement of the entrance walkway, and an addition of an expanded covered entrance way in a colonial Williamsburg style.

In the near future, a second drive-thru teller lane will be added and the existing drive-up ATM will be relocated for improved accessibility.

In keeping with its community investment philosophy, Consumers National Bank has engaged local contractor Wheeler Construction for the renovation project.
