Inside the building, a new customer service representative office will be created where new accounts can be opened and loan applications can be taken. A centrally located waiting area will be established with ample seating and improved lighting. A completely redesigned teller line will be created, including a new video monitor displaying news and bank information. New carpet, wall paper and paint will provide a fresh look to the interior as well.

On the outside of the building, a second drive-thru teller lane will be added and the existing drive-up ATM will be relocated for improved accessibility. The bank is also erecting a new identification sign that will make it easier for drivers to locate the bank on West State Street. The sign’s new design will feature a digital message board and will conform to the current zoning requirements of the city of Alliance.

In keeping with its community investment philosophy, Consumers National Bank has engaged local contractor Alliance Ventures for the renovation project.
